

Retrospective Assessment of Categories of Animal Welfare Impact

Background

By 2030, CCAC will require animal users to complete a Categories of Animal Welfare Impact assessment. This looks at the lifetime experiences of an animal that has undergone scientific observation/manipulation as part of a research or teaching program.

This assessment will replace the current Categories of Invasiveness ranking, which only categorizes the current protocol and does not take into account previous manipulations which may have occurred in the animal's lifetime. This is more applicable to animals maintained in a research facility, but as more information is gathered, the assessment will be applied to wildlife research as well.

In the meantime, CCAC is requesting that researchers complete a retrospective assessment of animal welfare impact and report this on the Post-Approval Monitoring Form.
