FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

#1 – What is the UM Bachelor of Nursing (BN) Collaborative program with University College of the North (UCN)?

For the past 22 years, the University of Manitoba and the University College of the North (UCN) have had a collaborative partnership to deliver the Bachelor of Nursing program in The Pas and Thompson, Manitoba. The same BN curriculum is delivered at all three campuses.

- Theory and Clinical courses follow the same curriculum as the University of Manitoba.
- Bachelor of Nursing UM
- UCN has an on-site team of instructors and clinical education facilitators, as well as instructors from UM in all 3 years in the BN program.

#2 – Where are the UCN campuses located?

<u>The Pas</u> is a community located 6.5 hours (625km) North of Winnipeg, Manitoba. The heart of adventure territory, "Gateway to The North", and home of the Northern Manitoba Trapper's Festival; which is one of the longest running winter festivals in Canada.

<u>Thompson</u> is a community located 7.75 hours (762km) North of Winnipeg, Manitoba. The largest city in northern Manitoba. Many amenities of city living amongst the tranquility of nature.

There is a bookstore located at each UCN campus that can provide you with all your required textbooks and UM arm crests. Name tags need to be ordered directly from the University of Manitoba Bookstore. Clinical nursing scrubs need to be ordered from University of Manitoba or need to be dark navy blue with white, clean, indoor runners. Nursing Name Tag UM

Required Immunizations will not be done on campus. Students will need to have their immunizations done prior to coming to UCN at the Fort Garry Campus or will have to book their own appointment with at the Primary Health Center. Note: there may be a cost involved with having to have your immunizations done at Primary Health. <u>UM Immunization Program</u>

You are required to have your **required documents** completed prior to starting the academic year. Due date for all required documents is July 15 for the fall admission. After you've been accepted into an undergraduate program in the College of Nursing, and before the start of your program, there are a number of requirements you need to submit. This information is relevant for all newly admitted students to our undergraduate programs: Bachelor of Nursing (Fort Garry site); Bachelor of Nursing (UCN Collaborative Cohort); Bachelor of Midwifery. #4 – If I accept an offer to study nursing at UCN in The Pas or Thompson, how will it affect my	
status on the waitlist for the BN program at Fort Garry campus in Winnipeg?	
Accepting an offer to study in The Pas or Thompson will not affect your waitlist position for	
a seat at the Fort Garry campus in Winnipeg.	





#5 - If I am admitted to the UCN campus Collaborative University College of the North Cohort Nursing program in the Pas or Thompson for this, can I transfer back to the Fort Garry campus after a term if I choose to?

Students are expected to study for the duration of their BN degree at the campus location where an offer is made. This means relocating to The Pas or Thompson, live in the community during the term, and will have to attend in-person.

#6 – If I accept an offer to study at UCN at The Pas or Thompson campus for Fall 2023, am I eligible to apply to the Fort Garry campus for the Winter 2024 intake?

Students accepting an offer to student the BN program at a UCN campus are not eligible to apply for Fort Garry campus in subsequent terms (for the BN program).

#7 – Is there a policy and guidelines for transferring to an alternate campus within the Bachelor of Nursing program?

Must meet required guidelines to be considered for a transfer. Must contact Academic Advisor and Program Coordinator at UCN before initiating a transfer.

#8 – What are the benefits of completing the Bachelor of Nursing program at a UCN campus in The Pas or Thompson?

- ✓ Small class sizes. On average NURS courses have 20 students per site. You will have the opportunity to really know your instructors and classmates.
- ✓ Smaller classes can improve well-being of students by reducing stress and anxiety, improving mental health, and promoting a sense of belonging and community.
- ✓ Classes at both UCN campuses run from September through April.
- ✓ Courses only run once per academic year.
- ✓ The Northern Health Region (NRHA) is geographically the largest of the five RHAs in the province of Manitoba. Within the Region there are: 2 cities (Thompson and Flin Flon) 6 towns (The Pas, Gillam, Grand Rapids, Leaf Rapids, Lynn Lake, Snow Lake).
- ✓ Clinical rotations tend to stay within The Pas and Thompson sites.
